

Club Rules

- 1. All gymnasts must be dressed in appropriate clothing with hair tied back and no jewellery. New studs must be covered with a plaster. No belly piercings are permitted, under any circumstance.
- 2. Gymnasts should be on time for sessions. Repeated lateness may result in a loss of space.
- 3. Our minimum termly attendance for Recreational gymnasts is 85%, and 95% for Competition Squad. Repeatedly falling below this may result in loss of space.
- **4.** The club take no responsibility for any mistakes made due to Parents/Guardians not reading letters or the display board.
- 5. The Parent Gallery should always be left neat and tidy.
- 6. Coaches are happy to discuss any queries that arise. However, our coaches have the right to be treated with respect. We will not tolerate what we perceive as aggressive or impolite behaviour towards any of our staff or helpers. We will not tolerate abuse via social media. Any evidence of this will be reported to British Gymnastics and the Police.
- 7. Photography is not allowed by any unauthorised person, and under no circumstances from the Viewing Gallery. Authorisation to photograph your own child can be obtained from the Head Coach only.
- 8. Within the Gymnasium environment, our coaches have the final say on any decisions made regarding lessons and placements within certain classes. They undergo a wide range of training in order to volunteer or coach and their knowledge and experience is vital to the club.
